All convention delegates and guests are invited to enjoy an afternoon of friendly competition at the 13th Annual PSATS Trustees Insurance Golf Tournament on Hershey Country Club's beautiful and challenging East Course.

The tournament will begin at 11 a.m. with a shotgun start and is expected to end around 4 p.m. A full refund will be given only if the club cancels the tournament because of inclement weather.

Golfers will be competing for first-, second-, and third-place team prizes, as well as cash and merchandise prizes for anyone who gets a hole-in-one.

The registration fee is \$95 per delegate (*\$150 for all others*), which includes greens fees, cart fees, a boxed lunch, and prizes. Participants are responsible for their own transportation to the country club and should arrive by 10:15 a.m. for driving and putting practice.

## **Trip #1 – Harley-Davidson Factory Tour, York**

**\$40 per person**

The Harley-Davidson Vehicle Operations in York is the largest Harley-Davidson motorcycle manufacturing facility in the world, employing nearly half the company's production workforce. The plant covers more than 230 acres and has more than 3,200 employees working around the clock to assemble Harley's Touring and Softail models.

The bus will leave the Chocolate Lobby Portico at the Hershey Lodge at 9 a.m. Your journey at the factory will begin with an introductory movie and continue on the factory floor for a behind-the-scenes look at the people, processes, and, most importantly, the products of this famous York factory. After the tour, lunch will be provided at a local buffet.

The bus will arrive back at the Chocolate Lobby Portico by 2:30 p.m. to allow those on this tour time to catch a bus to the Legislative Reception at the State Capitol Complex.

**NOTE:** This tour is limited to the first 54 registrants.

## **Trip #2 – Ephrata Cloister/Landis Valley Museum, Lancaster County**

**\$70 per person**

Join us on a visit to two of Dutch Country's best interpretive re-creations of early Pennsylvania life. Landis Valley Museum is a nationally significant living history museum that collects, conserves, exhibits, and interprets Pennsylvania German material, culture, history, and heritage from 1740 through 1940. The tour will also include a horse-drawn wagon ride.

Likewise, Ephrata Cloister is one of America's earliest religious communities, founded in 1732 by German settlers seeking spiritual goals, rather than earthly rewards. Gathered in unique European-style buildings, the community consisted of celibate Brothers and Sisters and a married congregation of families. At the zenith of the community in the 1740s and 1750s, about 300 members worked and worshiped at the Cloister. Today, this National Historic Landmark is open for tours, special programs, and ongoing research opportunities. The visit will include a guided walking tour of each venue, and lunch will be catered onsite.

The bus will leave the Chocolate Lobby Portico of the Hershey Lodge at 8:30 a.m. It is scheduled to arrive back at the Chocolate Lobby Portico by 3 p.m. to allow time for those on this tour to catch a bus to the Legislative Reception at the State Capitol Complex.

## **TUESDAY, APRIL 24**

### **Rainbow Dinner Theater, Lancaster**

**\$70 per person**

Guests are sure to laugh again on this return visit to the popular Rainbow Dinner Theater in Lancaster County.
