[DEP Helps Farmers in Chesapeake Bay to Improve Water Quality](#)

The state Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) have launched two programs that provide funding and technical assistance to help farmers implement best management

practices to benefit their operations and the Chesapeake Bay Watershed. Chesapeake Bay Agricultural Program Phase 2 provides \$2.8 million in funding to conservation districts in Adams, Chester, and Lancaster counties to help farmers improve water quality. Another \$900,000 is available to reimburse farmers across the watershed for costs of developing best management practices plans. [Click here](#) to learn more.
