DUNS Numbers Are No More as of Monday, April 4

Beginning Monday, April 4, 2022, the federal government will transition to the Universal Entity Identifier (UEI) number for all entities doing business with it and will no longer use the DUNS number issued by DUN and Bradstreet to uniquely identify entities. The UEI is assigned by the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) in the System for Award Management (SAM.gov).

All townships with active SAM.gov accounts do not need to take any action.

Your UEI number has been assigned and is viewable in your SAM.gov account and is currently located below the DUNS number on your entity registration record. It is recommended that township officials ensure that your township's DUNS number is available for historical references where needed as it will no longer be visible in your SAM.gov account after April 4, 2022.

As a reminder, SAM.gov accounts must be renewed annually and this service is ALWAYS free. For townships that set up a SAM.gov account last summer, your renewal will be a year from when you set up your account and will be noted in your account. Reminder: Township Reports Due Today

Township officials are reminded that there are several state filing deadlines today, March 31.

- Deadline for townships to claim [2021 liquid fuels tax refunds](#). As reported yesterday, townships must first contact the Board of Finance and Revenue so that an account can be set up and a prepopulated form furnished to the township. The Board cannot accept forms that cross out preprinted numbers. Please call 717-787-6534 or email edschreiner@patreasury.gov to request a form.
- [Form AG-385](#) due to the auditor general (*required for foreign fire tax distribution and municipal pension aid*)
- Municipal Act 205 Actuarial Valuation Reports for municipalities with pension plans, which are due to the auditor general today. [Click here](#) to learn more.
