Townships Win Over Half the Multimodal Projects Funding

Gov. Tom Wolf announced 56 highway, bridge, bike, and pedestrian projects in 28 different counties that were selected for \$47.8 million in funding through the Multimodal Transportation Fund. Some of the projects will also help local governments address bridges and roads in need of repair or replacement. More than half of the projects were awarded to townships or will directly benefit townships.

PennDOT evaluated the applications and made selections based on such criteria as safety benefits, regional economic conditions, the technical and financial feasibility, job creation, energy efficiency, and operational sustainability. [Click here](#) to learn more.
