### **Final reminder: ARP reports Due Tomorrow April 30, 2022**

Your annual report for year one ARP monies is due tomorrow, Saturday, April 30, 2022, no later than 11:59 pm. This will cover from the period of your receipt of the ARP monies in 2021 through March 31, 2022. PSATS remains available to assist until 5 p.m. today and until 2 p.m. on Saturday. Please note that all townships received a reminder email from Treasury. Please disregard if you have already filed. If you emailed or called Treasury with a technical issue and you do not receive a response by April 30, Treasury has stated that the Portal will remain open for your submission after the deadline to accommodate those who are experiencing technical issues.

**Today in History.....**

On April 29, 2004, the World War II Memorial opened in Washington, D.C. to thousands of visitors, providing overdue recognition for the 16 million U.S. men and women who served in the war. The memorial is located on 7.4 acres on the former site of the Rainbow Pool at the National Mall between the Washington Monument and the Lincoln Memorial. The Capitol dome is seen to the east, and Arlington Cemetery is just across the Potomac River to the west.
