### **Reminder: Act 13 Unconventional Gas Well Grant Applications Due October 21**

The 2022 Act 13 Unconventional Gas Well Fund (UGWF) grant deadline is October 21. Fire companies, rescue companies and emergency medical services throughout the 40 counties in which unconventional gas wells are located, or counties that directly border those counties, are eligible to apply for the grants.

Eligible projects include:

1. Obtaining professional national certification of members.
2. Purchase of firefighting, emergency medical, rescue, or air monitoring equipment used at or related to an unconventional gas well pad incident on, or related to, an unconventional gas well pad. All equipment purchased through the program will also include training on the equipment provided by the PSFA at no additional costs to the grant recipient(s).
3. Training classes and required educational materials to prepare for incidents at an unconventional gas well pad or related to the unconventional gas industry.

### **Today in History.....**

On October 7, 2003, actor Arnold Schwarzenegger was elected governor of California, the most populous state in the nation with the world's fifth-largest economy. Republican Schwarzenegger came out on top in the 11-week campaign to replace Gray Davis, who had earlier become the first United States governor to be recalled by the people since 1921. Schwarzenegger was one of 135 candidates on the ballot, which included career politicians, other actors and one adult-film star. The actor's romantic life previously captured the attention of the American public when he married television journalist and lifelong Democrat Maria Shriver, niece of the late President John F. Kennedy, in 1986. They separated in 2011 upon his return to acting.
