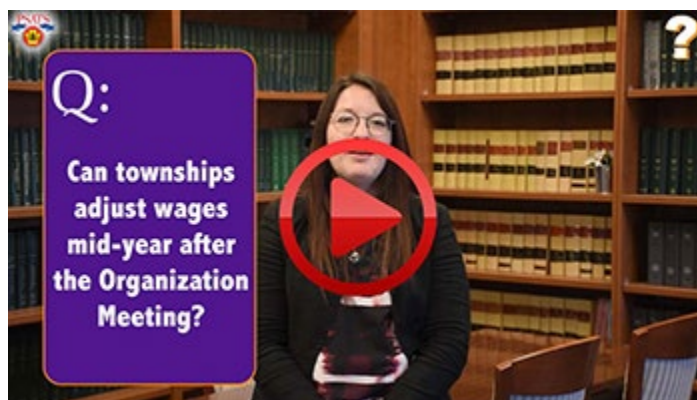

Reminder: Municipal Recycling Performance Grant Applications Due December 30

The Department of Environmental Protection is accepting applications for Section 904 recycling grants **until December 30**. This application period is for eligible materials recycled and marketed in calendar year 2021.

Grant funds will be awarded to municipalities based on the weight of source-separated recyclable materials recovered by municipal recycling programs and the population of the municipality as determined by the most recent decennial census.
