

Temporary Authorization for Township Non-CDL Driver to Operate a CDL Vehicle

In accordance with 75 PaCS Section 1606(b)(8), the driver named below, who is at least 18 years old and is in possession of their valid driver's license and this certificate, is temporarily authorized to operate a CDL vehicle until ___/___/20___ without needing a commercial driver's license while within the boundaries of this township for the purpose of removing snow or ice from roadways by plowing, sanding or salting.

The township is issuing this certificate because either (1) the regular CDL driver is unable to operate the vehicle or (2) the township has determined that a snow or ice emergency exists that requires additional assistance. In terms of the expiration date of this authorization, if using situation #1, this date can extend through the winter snow plowing season, or until the original driver returns to work, whichever is earlier. If using situation #2, this date can never be more than seven days in the future, as that is the length of time for which an emergency declaration can exist. If the emergency continues beyond that initial seven-day declaration, the township would need to declare another emergency, and re-issue new certificates of authorization to those drivers with a new expiration date of no more than seven days.
